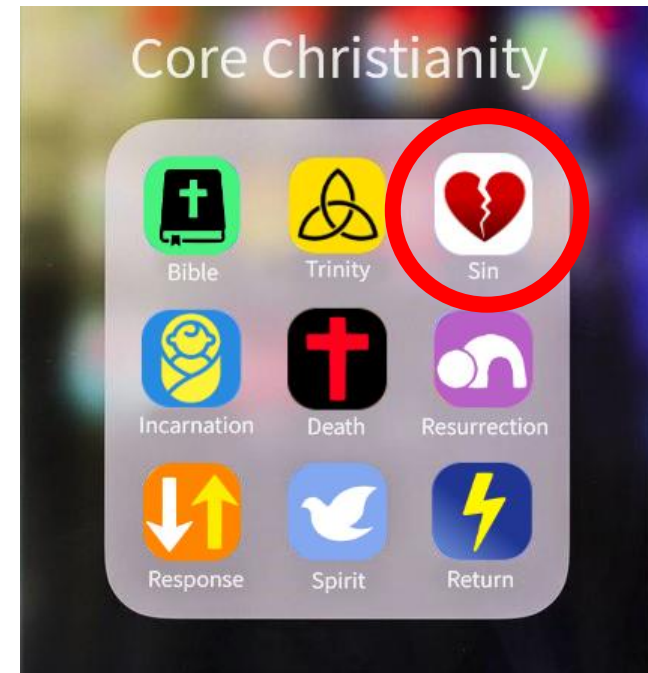

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8

What are the key elements of the gospel according to Paul? (v.3-4)

What evidence does Paul give for Jesus’ resurrection?

*Do you think these evidence are reliable and convincing? Why or why not?

Read Matthew 27:62- 28:10

Why did the religious leaders ask the governor Pilate to put trained Roman guards to guard Jesus’ tomb? (27:62-66)

“that liar” the religious leaders’ thinks that Jesus lied about his resurrection.

The women went to Jesus’ tomb to pay their respects to a dead Jesus, but what did they find instead? What were they told?

Describe in your own words their interaction with Jesus when they saw him.

Read 1 Corinthians 15:17-22

If Jesus did not rise from the dead, can our sins be forgiven and is there hope beyond death?

*Why do you think Jesus’ resurrection makes such a big difference to the two important things above?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:42-44

For those who will be resurrected in Christ, what kind of body will they have?

How reliable do you think eye-witness accounts are? Is this kind of evidence something you accept to show that the resurrection of Jesus might be true?

If Jesus’ resurrection really happened, how would it change your view of who Jesus is? How would you respond to him then?
