

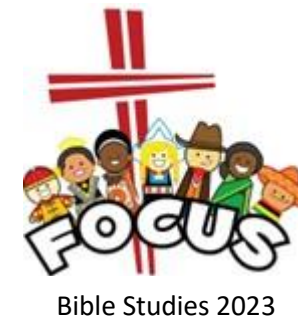
## A Powerful Name

## A Powerful Name



Have you ever seen something miraculous happen? How did you respond?

How many times does Peter say “you” in vs 13-16?

**Read Acts 3:1-26**

How was this man healed? (vs 6,16)

Peter is quite accusatory here – why does this make sense given who he is speaking to?

How does he respond to being healed? (vs 8, 11)

The Jews dishonoured God’s chosen king – you might not have been the one who nailed him to the cross, but we have all dishonoured him too – what does Peter say we need to do to be forgiven?

Why was it significant that he was lame from birth and was recognised by all those in the temple? (vs 2, 10)

God has made us an exciting offer – have you ever thought about accepting it?

What opportunity does the physical healing bring in this chapter?
