Have you ever seen something miraculous happen? How did you respond?

How many times does Peter say “you” in vs 13-16?

Read Acts 3:1-26

How was this man healed? (vs 6,16)

Peter is quite accusatory here – why does this make sense given who he is speaking to?

How does he respond to being healed? (vs 8, 11)

How do we share the guilt for disowning and killing Jesus? What implications does this have for us?

Why was it significant that he was lame from birth and was recognised by all those in the temple? (vs 2, 10)

Part of becoming a Christian is repenting – saying one big “sorry” to God. But even when we have been Christian for a long time, we still need to confess to God both the big and small things we do each day which dishonour him.

What opportunity does the physical healing bring in this chapter?

How often do you take the time to repent?

List the different names for Jesus used in verses 13-22:

As Christians even when mess up, we are still safe and secure because of what Jesus has done. It is not by our own power or godliness that we are forgiven, but because of what Jesus has done. It is right to say sorry to God when we mess up, even though we already have salvation guaranteed.

What does each one mean/tell us about who Jesus is?
