STUDY 2 — THE SPREAD OF SIN & CREATION REBOOT

THE STORY SO FAR

Retell the story of creation and the Fall to each other (in pairs or to the group) using whatever way suits you (eg picture, stories, diagrams).

What questions do you have about the OT? Make a list and mark off the ones which the studies have answered.

READ GENESIS 6:1-10,11-22.

From Genesis 6:5-8, how did sin spread across the earth? How bad was it? (ie How deep and how wide?)

From Genesis 6:7-8,11-13,17, how did God feel about sin and what did God plan to do about sin?

From Genesis 6:18-21, what did God promise to do in order to save people?

THINK ABOUT IT.

Why did God say he will destroy everything but doesn't actually destroy everything?

- a) God was just trying to scare people.
- b) God was not powerful enough to destroy everyone.
- c) God did not actually want to destroy everything.
- d) God still loved human beings.
- e) Noah was the only good person and did not deserve to die.
- f) God changed his mind.

In your opinion do you think the people (including women and children) deserved to be completely destroyed? Explain.

In your opinion do you think Noah and his family deserved to be saved? Explain.

READ GENESIS 8:15-21.

What did God promise Noah ?

In your opinion, do you think sin is still a problem for humans? Why?

APPLICATION

If you had the power to do anything, how would you fix the problem of sin in the world?

From your understanding of today's story, how did God deal with the problem of sin the world?

Compare your way with God's way of dealing with sin, what are the differences and similarities between your way and God's way?

What does it teach you about God's way of dealing with the problem of sin? Give reasons.
