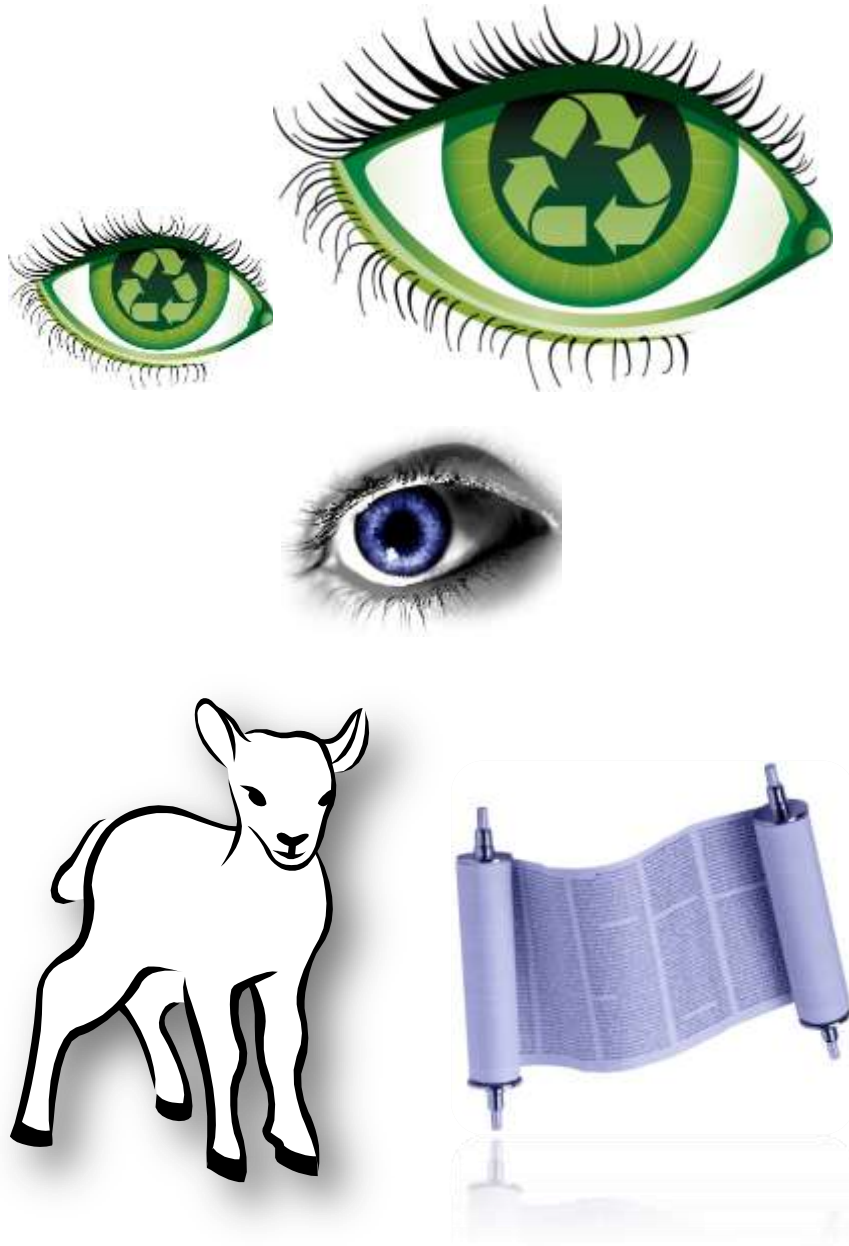

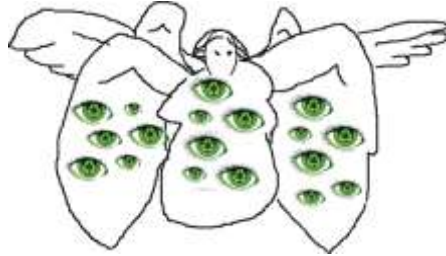
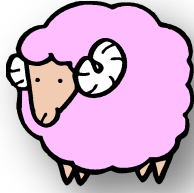

# The Book of Revelations

---

## **Key to symbols.**

**Four living creatures** (Ezekiel 1- always appear when God is around)

**The Lamb** ( the sacrifice needed to save lives Exodus 12:1-3)

**The Lion of the Tribe of Judah** - King of Israel - Saviour

**The Root of David** - The Kingly saviour (Ezekiel 37:24)

**Seven** – number of completion or fullness (Gen 1)

**Horns** – Kings or rule or power or authority (Daniel 8:8)

**Eyes** – not explained but also appears in Ezekiel 1.

**Twenty four** – occurs in 1 Chronicles 24 as the complete representative of Israel's priesthood.
